What is the EPOQUE Project?

The project ÉPOQUE promotes a smart specialization of prospective teachers, scientists and engineers through an environmental portfolio ready to be integrated into the university syllabuses. It creates a new generation of green teachers, green scientists, green engineers in the context of higher education modernization agenda connected to SMEs and organizations (including schools).

The project is based on a transfer of know-how and good practices between selected partners from Northern and Southern Europe, but also Baltic and Mediterranean Countries. The project will facilitate communication between European countries and develop a variety of results to support the promotion of sustainable development, which is necessary to modernize both the higher education curricula as the adult education programmes, by building up the capacities of future professionals towards a more sustainable usage of natural resources and creation of bridges between the provision of knowledge and the labour market needs. - Energy Management System Guidelines
- Adaption of these to an eLearning course that will then be freely available
